Footnotes

SELF INSURED settled outside a rival, came out on the turn and seven wide into the stretch, rallied under right handed urging while drifting in and brushing with SMOOTH AND SAVVY past midstretch, gained the lead outside rivals in deep stretch and gamely held. SMOOTH AND SAVVY settled outside then off the rail, also came out on the turn and six wide into the stretch, rallied between horses while drifting in and being floated in and brushed with the winner past midstretch, continued between foes late and went willingly to the wire. SCOTTISH DIAMOND went up inside to duel for the lead, inched away into the stretch, kicked clear a bit off the rail and held on well to deep stretch then saved the show. GANDOLF stalked off the rail, bid three deep on the turn and to the stretch and weakened some in the final furlong. HARALDO (CHI) angled in and saved ground off the pace, continued inside in the stretch and improved position. ACQUIRE THE FIRE chased off the rail on the backstretch and turn, split horses into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. CORONEL MOLDES wide early, settled off the rail then angled in on the backstretch, came out leaving the turn and five wide into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. SIDEPOCKET LOU stalked outside, bid four wide on the turn and into the stretch and weakened. STORM BRAVE between foes early, chased outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch and lacked a further response. A CAT NAMED SNIPE had speed between horses then dueled outside a rival and between foes on the turn, dropped back into the stretch and gave way. CAYAMBE tugged his way between horses early, dropped back and was pulled up on the backstretch and vanned off. Following a claim of foul by the rider of SMOOTH AND SAVVY against SELF INSURED, the latter was disqualified and placed second for interference in the stretch.
