HOLLADAY ROAD had speed outside rivals then angled in on the first turn, set the pace inside, responded when challenged leaving the second turn, inched away again under urging in the stretch and won clear. BLUEGRASS REWARD stalked the winner a bit off the rail, bid alongside that one a quarter mile out, was not a match in the stretch but clearly second best. KILLER BEAR three deep early, chased outside a rival then between horses into the second turn, angled to the inside on that turn, continued along the rail in the stretch and picked up the show. BIG BURLY BOY three wide in the run to the first turn, stalked off the rail on the backstretch and second turn and lacked the needed response in the stretch. VERY FAIR broke inward, was between horses early then chased inside, came out on the second turn and did not rally. STAR NICHOLAS a bit crowded at the start, settled inside then just off the rail leaving the backstretch, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and was not a threat. QUILLOTANO broke a bit slowly, settled off the rail then outside a rival, went three deep on the backstretch and second turn and lacked a response in the stretch.
