ALMOST BETTER four wide into the first turn, stalked outside, went three deep on the second turn and into the stretch, bid outside a rival, took a short lead a sixteenth out and held gamely between foes under urging. LITE THAT BABY UP chased inside then went between horses leaving the backstretch, came four wide into the stretch and finished gamely three deep on the line. BEAST OF BOURBON saved ground, awaited room leaving the second turn, came out into the stretch, was in a bit close off heels then split foes past midstretch and rallied along the rail. HURRY HOME CLOVER stalked off the rail, bid outside a rival leaving the second turn, took the lead into the stretch and weakened late. JAY'S FIRETRUCK chased outside, went three deep on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. SUANCES CANDY pulled his way to the front off the rail, angled in and set the pace inside, dueled leaving the second turn and weakened in the stretch. HY DANGER bobbled at the start, angled in and chased inside, came off the rail on the second turn then angled back in and could not summon the necessary response. CHICO SUERTE settled off the rail then three deep on the backstretch and second turn, came four wide into the stretch and did not rally. WARREN'S JOE T. saved ground chasing the pace, dropped back on he second turn, came out into the stretch and weakened. HOOSIER DIDDY angled in and settled outside a rival then between foes, angled to the inside entering the stretch and

was not a threat.
