CALIFORNIA CHROME stalked the pace outside a rival, bid three deep leaving the turn and into the stretch to gain the lead, inched away in midstretch and won clear under left handed urging. MOVING DESERT angled in and stalked inside, came out on the turn and three wide into the stretch, could not match the winner in the final sixteenth but edged a rival for the place. GANGNAM GUY saved ground chasing the pace, continued inside in the stretch and was edged for second. BETTER BET had good early speed and angled in, dueled inside, fought back on the turn, came a bit off the fence in the stretch and weakened. SOLID WAGER stalked between horses then outside a rival on the turn, swung four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. WILLIE B AWESOME angled in and dueled outside a rival then between horses leaving the turn and into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. BETTING MCCANN CAN pulled some and chased three deep on the backstretch and outside a rival on the turn, came out into the stretch and did not rally.
