Footnotes

ATHINA LEE pulled her way to the early lead, angled in and set the pace inside then a bit off the rail into and on the turn and into the stretch, drifted out in the final furlong and held under urging. FLAXEN MAIDEN dropped back outside then angled in on the backstretch, moved up inside leaving the turn, came out in upper stretch and closed willingly to jut miss. HUERA BONITA chased inside, came out leaving the turn and three deep into the stretch and edged rivals for the show. PARTY BUS stalked between horses then a bit off the rail, came out some in the stretch and was edged for third between foes late. CONSENT saved ground stalking the pace, fell back a bit on the turn and lacked the needed late kick. WARREN'S CHASER hopped slightly then bobbed a bit at the start, chased between horses, angled to the inside into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. RICH IN TRADITION chased between horses on the backstretch and into the turn, continued alongside a rival into the stretch and did not rally. MARGIES RULE bumped at the start, stalked between rivals, steadied in tight a half mile out, went three deep on the turn and four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. STAR OF THE NIGHT had speed outside then stalked three deep, continued outside on the turn and four wide into the stretch and weakened. TAP TAP UR IT broke out and bumped a rival then was forced inward into another foe, pulled between horses on the backstretch, went four wide on the turn and five wide into the stretch and weakened. AND SHE WAS bobbed at the start, settled outside then off the rail to the stretch and failed to menace. PRECIOUS BEST settled outside then three deep, was between horses into the turn, dropped back off the rail and had little left for the stretch.
