Footnotes

CHOCTAW NATION unhurried inside then a bit off the rail, moved up outside on the second turn and four wide into the stretch, rallied under steady left handed urging to gain the lead in deep stretch and gamely prevailed. PLEASANTLY PERFECT stalked off the rail then steadied in tight on the first turn, pulled his way up three deep between foes on the backstretch, and briefly put his head in front, dueled between rivals into and on the second turn, regained the advantage a quarter mile out, inched clear in the stretch, fought back toward the inside in deep stretch and continued willingly to the wire. DURING sped to the early lead a bit off the rail, dueled between horses on the first turn then just off the inside on the backstretch, found the fence and fought back on the second turn, then could not match the top pair in the final furlong but held third. REBA'S GOLD four wide into the first turn, stalked outside then off the rail, was outside a rival into the stretch, came out and lacked the needed rally. NIGHT PATROL stumbled to his nose at the start, went up inside to press the pace on the first turn, stalked along the rail on the backstretch and second turn, came out in midstretch and could not summon the necessary response. TASTE OF PARADISE stalked outside then moved up four wide on the backstretch, dueled three deep into and on the second turn and weakened in the stretch. DECORADOR (ARG) unhurried off the rail then along the inside, came out into the stretch and was outrun.
