## **Footnotes**

THE BAT SIGNAL dueled inside, inched away a bit off the rail in upper stretch and held gamely under urging. STAR REDEEMER saved ground chasing the pace, moved up along the rail into the stretch and continued willingly to be second best. MR. ROD had good early speed and dueled between horses then outside the winner, weakened some in the stretch but held third. NASCAR JOHNNY four wide early, chased outside a rival then was in a bit tight between foes into the turn, continued off the rail, found the fence in the stretch but lacked the needed rally. BEAU GRIS in a bit tight just after the start, chased between foes then off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and weakened. YONKERS JOE between horses early, settled a bit off the rail, angled in on the turn, came out into the stretch and was not a threat. GENKI had speed three deep then stalked off the rail and three wide into the turn, came in a bit entering the turn, continued outside a rival, angled out four wide into the stretch and weakened.
