Footnotes

RECKLESS CAPOTE angled in and chased inside, moved up leaving the turn, came out nearing midstretch, gained the lead outside under some urging a sixteenth out and pulled clear. OL'DOGTOWN had good early speed and dueled off the rail, inched away briefly on the turn, came in some and battled alongside a rival leaving the turn, inched away again off the rail in midstretch, could not match the winner but clearly held second. TRUENO stalked the pace outside a rival, steadied sharply in tight between horses nearing the quarter pole, came out three deep into the stretch and bested the others. ENAMORADO hesitated to be away slowly, angled in and settled inside, moved up some on the turn, came out into the stretch and improved position. TEAR OF ALLAH broke slowly, had speed inside to stalk the pace, bid along the rail leaving the turn but weakened in the final furlong. PEMBA AT U. T. K. allowed to settle outside then alongside a rival, came out four wide into the stretch and was not a threat. KAYAKITYAK dueled outside the runner-up then stalked three deep leaving the turn, came four wide into the stretch and weakened. HALO'S LIMIT stalked off the rail then outside a rival, dropped back on

the turn and had little left for the stretch. WARREN'S CHARM settled outside a rival then inside on the backstretch and turn and failed to menace. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the incident on the turn between the second and third finishers but made no change when they ruled the incident did not alter the original order of finish.
