CHAMPAGNE PRINCE (GB) unhurried saving ground to the second turn, came out on that bend and five wide into the stretch and rallied gamely under a strong hand ride to prove best. KING CLEF settled outside a rival, moved up three deep into and on the second turn, came four wide into the stretch, took a short lead but could not match the winner. STORM WRECK off a bit slowly, saved ground off the pace, bid inside in the drive, got through and finished willingly. FUTURISTIC settled outside a rival, came out on the second turn and wide into the stretch with a late bid. HANUMAN HIGHWAY (IRE) chased between horses most of the way, lacked room off heels into the stretch, was in a bit tight in traffic in midstretch and could not offer the needed late kick. KALEMBERG (BRZ) pulled inside early, chased three deep on the backstretch, bid three deep on the second turn and was outfinished. IRISHEYESAREFLYING saved ground, moved up on the backstretch, came a bit off the rail on the second turn, lacked room into the stretch, was blocked and steadied off heels in traffic in midstretch and could not recover. ZIPPER SUP took the early lead and angled in, dueled inside on the backstretch and second turn and into the stretch but weakened in the final furlong. WEST COAST WARRIOR angled in and stalked the pace inside, was a bit off the rail in the stretch and was in tight in traffic in midstretch but weakened late. ALERT TO GO (FR) steadied when squeezed in the chute, went up three deep into the first turn, dueled outside a rival on the backstretch and second turn and between horses nearing the stretch, then weakened.
