Footnotes

NADIRA stalked the pace a bit off the rail to the stretch, then rallied under urging and wore down the runner-up late. TIGERMITE sped to the early lead, set the pace a bit off the rail, angled in on the turn and held on well but was caught late. RAGING JENNIE chased between horses on the backstretch and turn, waited in traffic a bit leaving the turn, came three deep into the stretch and gained the show late. SLAM INN was in a good position stalking the pace inside, came out in the stretch and lost third late. BIRD IN SPRING chased six wide on the backstretch and four wide on the turn, angled in some nearing the stretch and lacked the needed response. FAST GOAT stalked between horses on the backstretch and turn, was in a bit tight leaving the bend, angled in entering the stretch and did not rally. EXCESSIVELY SARAH unhurried a bit off the rail on the backstretch, found the inside on the turn and was not a threat. QUEENS HIGH close up stalking the pace three deep on the backstretch, went four wide on the turn, was a bit crowded leaving the bend and

weakened. KINDA LOUCHE well placed stalking the pace between horses to the stretch, also weakened. MODE OF THE WORLD between horses early, steadied on the backstretch to drop back, swung wide into the stretch and was not a factor. RACY RACHEL chased five wide between horses then dropped back off the rail, angled in on the turn and weakened. SILVER REVIEW unhurried well off the rail on the backstretch, moved up some outside on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and failed to menace.
