SEATTLE SHAMUS broke out a bit, sped to the early lead, dueled between horses then outside a rival on the second turn, regained the advantage nearing the stretch, kicked clear and held under energetic handling. WHITE BUCK off a bit slowly, settled inside, split horses into the second turn, came five wide into the stretch and finished well. BOSS EGO between horses early, stalked a bit off the rail then outside a rival on the second turn, came three deep into the stretch and picked up the show. PERIGNON (CHI) pulled early, chased outside a rival then a bit off the rail, continued inside on the second turn, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. STRIKING SONG had good early speed and dueled inside, put a head in front on the second turn but weakened in the stretch. EGGBERT saved ground off the pace, dropped back on the second turn, swung wide into the stretch and was not a threat. SPICY STUFF prompted the pace three deep, fell back on the second turn and weakened. SAPORE DI MARE (ARG) off a bit slowly, stalked four wide on the first turn, lugged out into the backstretch, gave way readily and was eased.
