Footnotes

GAL HAS TO LIKE IT moved up quickly to take the early lead on the inside, set the pace down the backstretch, inched clear around the turn, drifted out through the stretch and held on for the score. GUIDOPANZINI chased on the outside, was caught three deep around the turn and into the lane, angled inside the winner in midstretch, drifted out late and just missed. FRENEMY chased on the outside down the backstretch, angled over to save ground around the turn, came off the rail leaving the quarter pole, angled out again in midstretch, drifted out late and was a clear third at the wire. NIGHT TIDE stalked the pace outside a rival into the turn and between horses on the turn, angled inside in the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. PLENNY OF HENNY chased on the outside down the backstretch and around the turn, came into the stretch four wide, remained well off the rail through the lane and did offer the necessary rally. PUT IT THERE stalked the pace inside a rival into the turn, began to weaken on the rail around the turn and gave way in the lane.
