UNUSUAL HEATWAVE squeezed a bit at the start, chased outside then three deep on the backstretch, continued outside on the turn, angled to the inside nearing the stretch, came out in midstretch, rallied under vigorous handling to collar the runner-up late and proved best. ROUSING SERMON stalked inside, came out into the stretch to bid alongside the pacesetter, took the lead, inched away in midstretch and held on well but could not withstand the winner late. GOT EVEN sped to the early lead, set the pace along the inside, fought back along the rail into the stretch, weakened in the final furlong but clearly held third. CHAMPIONS GATE stalked a bit off the rail then between horses, came out three wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. DERBY GOLD close up tracking the pace outside then three deep into and on the turn and into the stretch and weakened. STONEY FLEECE chased just off the inside or between foes, continued inside on the turn, came out into the stretch and also weakened. A TOAST TO YOU bobbled at the start, saved ground off the pace, came out in the stretch and was not a threat.
