PULLA TRAIN bumped at the start, had speed off the rail then dueled outside a rival, took a short lead leaving the turn, fought back under urging between horses past midstretch and gamely prevailed. DREAMNOFATTICUS moved up inside to chase the pace, came out leaving the turn and three wide into the stretch, bid three deep then outside the winner past midstretch and continued willingly but was outgamed. BRO'S BRO went up inside to duel for the lead, fought back on the turn and in the stretch and weakened late but just held third. E K RULER stalked off the rail then a bit off the fence into and on the turn, came out into the stretch, lugged in from the whip a sixteenth out and was edged for the show. MR LEMON TREE bumped at the start, pulled a bit then settled outside a rival or a bit off the fence, came out into the stretch and again in upper stretch and bested the others. GENTLEMEN PETE chased between horses then inside on the turn and into the stretch, was a bit crowded a sixteenth out and lacked the needed response. ROB'S PAL broke a bit slowly, settled just off the rail then moved up outside a rival leaving the backstretch, split horses on the turn, came three wide into the stretch and did not rally. DALMATINAC bumped at the start, chased between horses then a bit off the rail, continued inside into and on the turn and weakened. TOP MARQUEE chased outside then three deep on the backstretch and turn, came four wide into the stretch and also weakened.
