TERA KITTY dueled on a short lead between rivals, inched clear into the stretch and held on gamely under urging. QUEEN OF WILSHIRE, settled well off the rail, moved up three deep on the turn and five wide into the stretch and closed willingly. RAISE A. DAISY, outside TIME AND AGAIN on the backstretch and a bit off the rail on the turn, just held third inside. SONG OF SUMMER, angled in on the backstretch, went around a rival into the stretch, came out and put in a late bid. IMPECCABLE STYLE, vied for command along the inside until nearing the stretch and weakened. SLEWREEN, forced the pace three deep between foes and also weakened. TIME AND AGAIN, off a bit slowly, went up inside into a good position on the backstretch, dropped back on the turn and had little left. THE WIND MORIA, showed good early speed and dueled four wide until nearing the stretch and also had little left. GREEDY GAL, fractious in the gate, settled off the rail and was outrun.
