SHE'S A SENSATION settled toward the inside, went around a rival leaving the turn, came out some in the stretch and rallied under some urging to prove best. MILT'S DREAM forced the early pace between horses then stalked the leader into and on the turn, bid outside that one leaving the bend and took a clear lead into the stretch but could not hold off the winner. PETITE CAFE settled between horses on the backstretch and a bit off the rail on the turn and picked up the show. PLEASE BE SEATED settled between horses on the backstretch and off the rail on the turn and lacked a late response. FAVORITE MISS close up four wide early, stalked off the rail on the backstretch and turn and weakened. HUNTER'S CRAFT bumped early, angled in and saved ground unhurried, steadied off heels into the stretch, came out and failed to menace. NAMORA allowed to settle four wide, continued outside on the turn and gave way. ISLAND JUBILEE dueled three deep early then angled in on a clear lead into the turn, battled briefly inside the runner-up leaving the bend, drifted out in midstretch and weakened. SWEEPING BISCUIT was sent up inside to force the early pace, stalked along the rail into the turn, dropped back, then was eased in the stretch.
