Footnotes

ROMAN DANCER sped to the early lead and angled in, dueled inside on the turn and in the stretch and gamely inched away late under urging while drifting out some. SUNRAY SPIRIT stalked outside on the backstretch, bid three deep into the turn, then dueled outside the winner to deep stretch but could not match strides late. JANADEL (IRE) saved ground off the pace, came out on the turn and four wide into the stretch, then drifted in but picked up the show. THE WINE KING also saved ground off the pace, came out leaving the turn and three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed response. ROCK THE STONE broke slowly, saved ground outrun to the stretch, moved up into the lane, was in tight along the rail in midstretch and improved position. DEL CHIARO forced in and shut off at the start, settled toward the inside, came out into the stretch, was in tight between horses in midstretch and failed to menace. WEED RUNNER veered in sharply onto rivals at the start, settled a bit off the rail, came out into the stretch and did not rally. DIFFERENT CLASS bumped and forced in at the start, stalked a bit off the rail then bid between horses into the turn, found the rail leaving the bend, was in a bit tight in midstretch and weakened. DUE SEASON had speed along the inside chasing the winner but steadied off that one's heels nearing the turn, dropped back, steadied again when squeezed between foes in midstretch and weakened. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the run nearing the far turn but made no change when they ruled the incident did not alter the original order of finish.
