### Footnotes

FASHION TREND pulled her way between horses and was in a bit tight into the first turn, tugged outside horses on the backstretch, came four wide into the stretch, rallied under urging to gain the lead in deep stretch and proved best. ROMAN CHIC took the early lead and angled in, set a pressured pace along the inside, fought back when headed into the stretch and continued willingly inside to edge a rival for the place. FOR THE MEMORIES angled in and prompted the pace outside the runner-up, took a short lead into the stretch, fought back between horses in deep stretch and held third. WOODEN SKY between foes early, stalked outside a rival, bid outside foes on the second turn, went three deep into the stretch and was outfinished. EMPRESS WAY settled inside then a bit off the rail leaving the backstretch, came out into the stretch and could not offer the necessary late kick. LOVE THAT MELODY stalked the pace inside, came a bit off the rail for room in the stretch, tried to go between horses in deep stretch and steadied, then steadied again in tight nearing the wire.
