**Footnotes**

COURTSIDE sped to the early lead, set the pace a bit off the rail then inside and drew off in the stretch under a steady hand ride and a snug hold late. BERTRAN HILL outside a rival early, stalked the winner along the inside to the stretch, was not a match in the drive but second best. MEMPHIS chased off the rail then three deep into the turn, continued off the inside, came out some into the stretch and picked up the show. ITSSULTRYINTHECAPE was in a good position chasing the pace three deep then off the rail on the turn, came a bit wide into the stretch and was edged for the show. MAGNIFICENT BLEND between rivals early, stalked outside or off the rail, came three wide into the stretch and lacked a rally. BIG BAD LEROYBROWN chased a bit off the rail, split horses into the turn, angled to the inside on the bend and could not offer the necessary response. ABSOLUTLYPOSITIVLY settled off the rail then outside, angled in alongside a rival on the turn and was not a threat. ASHEN hesitated to be away behind the field, pulled hard when rank between horses and steadied on the backstretch, angled in and stalked inside and weakened in the stretch. BERT'S LAW broke through the gate before the start, stalked inside then dropped back leaving the backstretch and on the turn and lacked a further response. CLASSY LION stalked the pace between horses, dropped back into the turn and gave way.
