Footnotes

DOWNHILL DIVA stalked a bit off the rail, bid outside the pacesetter on the second turn, took the lead between horses a quarter mile out, inched away inside in the stretch and won clear under some urging. TORO BONITO chased inside then a bit off the rail, came out into the stretch, angled inward a sixteenth out and just got the place. AWESOMEMUNDO stalked off the rail, bid three deep on the second turn then between horses a quarter mile out, could not match the winner in the final furlong and was edged for second between foes. ELVIES LANE chased off the inside, bid four wide leaving the second turn and into the stretch and was outfinished for a minor award. CATCHY TUNE stumbled to her nose at the start, settled just off the rail chasing the pace, came out in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. PURE CLASS sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, fought back along the rail on the second turn but weakened in the stretch.
