FIGHTING HUSSAR stalked a bit off the rail then between foes on the backstretch and turn, angled to the inside in upper stretch, bid along the fence under left handed urging past midstretch, gained a short lead late and gamely prevailed. THE HUMANCOMPLAINT was a bit slow into stride, settled just off the rail, came out leaving the turn and four wide into the stretch and rallied outside foes late. TORREYS K T M saved ground stalking the pace, came out in upper stretch and rallied between foes late. WINNINRULZ moved up between horses to duel for the lead, battled outside a rival on the turn, inched away into the stretch, continued just off the rail, fought back outside the winner in deep stretch and was edged for a minor award late. STRETCH broke in onto a foe, stalked three deep, went four wide on the turn and three wide into the stretch to loom a threat but lacked the needed late kick. GENTLEMEN PETE squeezed a bit at the start, settled outside a rival then off the rail, split horses in midstretch and was outfinished. ALL STAR BELL broke out and bumped a foe, went up to press the pace three deep then stalked three wide on the turn and into the stretch and weakened. MARK'S CAT had good early speed and angled in, duelled inside, fought back on the turn, steadied in tight along the rail when the winner went past in upper stretch and also weakened.
