Footnotes

CAPO BASTONE settled inside, came out in upper stretch, rallied under a vigorous hand ride and a left handed tap of the whip past midstretch, angled out off the heels of a rival past the sixteenth pole and ran past the runner-up late under confident handling. I'M WIDE AWAKE had good early speed and angled in, dueled inside, inched away from his pace rival in deep stretch but could not hold off the winner. DISTINCTIV PASSION angled in and dueled outside the runner-up, battled alongside that one in the stretch, drifted out some in deep stretch and clearly bested the others. KRIPKE chased between horses then outside a rival, continued a bit off the rail leaving the turn and lacked a rally. EL SABIOS saved ground chasing the pace, fell back some a half mile out, went outside a rival on the turn and did not rally. IVE STRUCK A NERVE chased between horses then inside on the turn, came out into the stretch and lacked the necessary response three deep on the line. PRINCE TELEMACHUS steadied when squeezed at the start, settled outside a rival, angled to the inside in the stretch and was not a threat. DENZEL lunged then bobbled a bit at the start, stalked four wide then three deep leaving the backstretch, angled in outside a rival into the stretch and weakened. PICK SIX JOE broke out and steadied, settled off the rail, angled in on the turn and was not a factor.
