INCLUDE ME OUT saved ground chasing the pace, moved up inside on the second turn, came out into the stretch, gained the advantage outside SWITCH nearing midstretch, inched clear, drifted out from the whip in deep stretch but held on gamely. STAR BILLING settled outside a rival then a bit off the rail, also moved up inside on the second turn, came out into the stretch and again nearing midstretch and finished well to just miss. AMANI (CHI) bobbled at the start, angled in and settled inside then a bit off the rail, came out on the second turn and three deep into the stretch, angled in some past midstretch and gained the show late. SWITCH pulled her way along and angled in, dueled inside, kicked clear on the backstretch, set the pace along the inside, fought back when challenged in the stretch and weakened late. QUAINLY allowed to settle along the inside, saved ground to the stretch and lacked the needed rally. ZAFEEN'S PEARL (GB) chased outside a rival, came three wide into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. KAYCE ACE in a bit tight between horses into the first turn, came out and pressed the pace three deep then stalked outside a rival, dropped back leaving the second turn, was between foes into the stretch and weakened. GREAT HOT (BRZ) three deep into the first turn, angled in and dueled between horses then stalked a bit off the rail on the backstretch, angled in for the second turn, was between horses leaving that turn and also weakened.
