CAMRYN KATE stalked outside a rival then off the rail, bid alongside the pacesetter on the second turn to take the lead, inched a way leaving the turn, kicked clear in the stretch and held sway under some urging and steady handling. BURNS TURN chased inside then a bit off the rail, split horses leaving the second turn, continued off the inside in the stretch and held second between rivals late. ROYAL EMPRESS (IRE) pulled her way along inside to chase the pace, came out into the stretch, split rivals in midstretch, angled in for room and finished with interest inside. MELTARIB three deep into the first turn, chased outside a rival then three wide leaving the backstretch and on the second turn and was edged for a minor award between foes late. TOOMANYTOMATOES angled in on the first turn and saved ground, came out leaving the backstretch, went outside a rival on the second turn and three deep passing the quarter pole, came four wide into the stretch and was outfinished for a minor share. THE ONLY KEY (GB) chased a bit off the rail then outside a rival, was in a bit tight between horses leaving the second turn, came out into the stretch and finished with some interest. NOSPEIGHTINTENDED sped to the early lead and angled in, pulled some while opening a commanding advantage on the first turn, set the pace inside, dueled briefly nearing the quarter pole and weakened.
