### Footnotes

SPRING BLOOM saved ground chasing the pace, came out in upper stretch, rallied under urging to the front between foes a sixteenth out and proved best. MISS PIPPA bobbled at the start, chased outside the winner, also came out in the stretch, bid three deep past midstretch and just held second. BIORHYTHM had speed four wide then pulled her way to a clear lead and angled in, opened up on the backstretch, continued clear into the stretch, came a bit off the rail in the drive, could not match the winner in the final sixteenth, was edged for second but gamely held third. LA ZUBIA (GB) angled in and chased outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch and split horses four wide on the line. PLAZA DE INDIAS (CHI) a bit slow to begin and steadied when squeezed, angled in and settled outside a rival then off the rail on the second turn, came out in the stretch and put in a late bid six wide on the wire. SILVER HUSTLER chased inside then a bit off the rail, went outside a rival on the second turn and three deep into the stretch, came out in the drive and split horses five wide on the line. PERFECTA angled in and settled a bit off the rail then inside, came out into the stretch and found her best stride late between foes. HIGH JINKS (BRZ) saved ground chasing the pace throughout and was outfinished in the stretch. FREEDOM REIGNS (IRE) settled off the pace inside, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally.
