Footnotes

UNUSUAL SUSPECT three deep early, angled in outside a rival on the first turn, found the inside in the stretch the first time, moved up inside on the final turn and into the stretch, came out and split horses with a bid past midstretch to gain a short lead under urging in deep stretch, drifted in and just held. RICHARD'S KID angled in and chased a bit off the rail, came out leaving the last turn and four wide into the stretch, drifted in, bid outside foes past midstretch and continued willingly to the wire. CHURCH SERVICE angled in and settled off the pace inside then a bit off the rail, came out on the final turn and four wide into the stretch and gained the show late. GANGBUSTER steadied between horses into the first turn, angled in and settled off the pace inside, cut the corner into the stretch and rallied along the fence to just miss the third. GHETTO (GB) took the early lead and set the pace inside, dueled along the rail, inched away again on the final turn, came a bit off the rail in the stretch and weakened late. QUARTER MOON stalked off the rail, bid alongside a rival in the stretch the first time then three deep on the backstretch and into the last turn, continued off the inside leaving that turn and into the stretch and weakened. SIR DAVE angled in and chased off the rail, went outside a rival leaving the final turn and three deep into the stretch and also weakened. BIG BOOSTER settled just off the rail chasing the pace, fell back on the last turn, was between foes a quarter mile out and had little left for the stretch. ZAPPA stalked inside then a bit off the rail, bid between horses on the backstretch and into the last turn, dropped back on that turn and also had little left in the drive. A claim of foul by the rider of GANGBUSTER against the winner for alleged interference on the first turn was not allowed by the stewards, who ruled the incident did not warrant a disqualification.
