QUICK ENOUGH stalked off the rail then outside a rival leaving the turn, came out some in the stretch and rallied under urging to gain the lead in deep stretch and gamely prevailed. WINTER CAMP sped to the early lead, set the pace inside and held on well but was overtaken late. SQUARE DEAL between foes early, stalked a bit off the rail then inside, came out in the stretch, bid between the top pair in deep stretch and continued willingly. GRACE UPON GRACE stalked inside, came out into the stretch and again in midstretch and bested the others. BRADIUM broke on top then chased four wide, dropped back into the turn, angled in on the bend, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. UNCLE JEEP broke a bit slowly, chased between foes, came out leaving the turn and three deep into the stretch and could not summon the necessary response. MALLINSON ROAD (NZ) was in a good position stalking the pace three deep, went four wide into the stretch and weakened. LORD IN COMMAND broke into the side of the gate in a slow start, angled in and settled off the pace inside and was always outrun.
