**Footnotes**

DELUXE BUS pulled his way along off the rail then between horses leaving the backstretch, stalked inside on the turn, advanced under urging along the rail in midstretch, came out a sixteenth from home and rallied to get up on the wire. FREE TIME sped to the early lead, inched away on the backstretch, set the pace inside, came a bit off the rail in the stretch and held on well but was caught late. RIBAT stalked off the rail then three deep into and on the turn, was bumped and forced four wide leaving the turn and into the stretch and edged a rival for third. EXCESSARIO pulled his way along inside stalking the pace, inched forward on the turn, came out off heels and steadied while bumping a rival a quarter mile out and was edged for the show. TART N SMART had speed between horses then stalked a bit off the rail, was bumped between foes and forced three deep a quarter mile out and into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong.
