Footnotes

SKIMMING pulled a bit while sprinting to the early lead, dueled inside on the first turn, inched away under a snug hold on the backstretch, kicked clear on the second turn and drew off in the stretch under energetic handling, then was taken under a hold in the final strides. PRIME TIMBER saved ground off the early pace, came out on the backstretch, angled back in for the second turn, was taken off the inside nearing midstretch and was second best. NATIONAL SAINT forced the pace between horses early and outside the winner on the first turn, stalked that one off the rail to the stretch, drifted in some and held third. FORTY ONE CARATS close up three deep early, chased off the inside, split horses into the stretch and lacked a late response. CASEY GRIFFIN caught a bit wide into the first turn, continued three deep between horses on that bend, chased between rivals on the backstretch, dropped back on the second turn and weakened. HAL'S PAL (GB) drifted out some into the first turn, continued between horses on that bend and on the backstretch, dropped back midway on the backstretch, came a bit wide into the stretch and did not rally. RIVER KEEN (IRE) caught wide into the first turn, continued four wide on that bend and into the backstretch, raced three deep into the second turn and moved up some, came a bit wider into the stretch and had nothing left.
