**Footnotes**

MIDNIGHT VELVET forced the pace between horses then stalked off the rail, bid between rivals again on the turn, fought back inside through a stiff drive and gamely prevailed under urging. THE DEMPSEY LOOK prompted the pace outside on the backstretch and four wide into the turn, continued three deep on the bend, took a short lead in upper stretch but was outgamed. HIGH SILVER sent inside to duel for command, inched away briefly into the second turn, fought back a bit off the rail on the bend and weakened in the final furlong but held third. NO MINIMUM close up prompting the pace between horses on the backstretch, was in a bit tight early on the turn, continued outside and weakened. DEE DEE'S CAT stalked a bit off the rail then inside on the turn, came out leaving the bend and three deep into the stretch and lacked a further response. LANGFUHR'S MAGIC off a bit slowly, chased inside, had the rider lose the whip nearing the sixteenth pole and was not a threat. EXPLOITIVE stalked off the rail then outside a rival, continued outside a foe into the stretch and did not rally.
