STEAL MY CHARM had good early speed and set the pace a bit off the rail, angled in on the turn, kicked clear in the stretch and held gamely under urging. GRACE GRYDER stalked four wide then three deep on the turn and into the stretch and was clearly second best. KEON close up tracking the winner a bit off the rail, angled in on the turn, came a bit off the fence again in the stretch and held third. LEGACY NORTH stalked outside a rival then off the rail on the turn and lacked the needed response. GAMBLERS RULE dropped back off the rail then angled in leaving the backstretch, came out leaving the turn and four wide into the stretch and improved position. BOEHLE a bit slow to begin, pulled her way between horses to chase the pace, steadied early on the turn, angled in, came out into the stretch and could not summon the necessary response. DIXIE HAWKS also broke a bit slowly, chased inside, was in tight off heels early on the turn, remained inside and did not rally. MOM KNOWS BEST chased three deep between horses then outside a rival on the turn, came three wide into the stretch and gave way.
