### Footnotes

CRAIG'S STORM chased between horses then a bit off the rail, split rivals in midstretch, gained the lead, inched away under some urging and held sway. SO BEHOLD chased outside, split rivals on the turn, came three deep into the stretch and gained the place. QUITYERBELLYACHING dropped back and saved ground off the pace, continued inside on the turn, came out in midstretch, split horses in deep stretch and gained the show. JOHNNY'S TIME prompted the pace three deep between foes, gained the lead three wide in the stretch and was outfinished. FRIENDLY HALF forced the pace four wide between horses then four wide on the turn and into the stretch and weakened. DONEITAGAIN contested the pace five wide on the backstretch, stalked outside on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and also weakened. NORCO PAL sent inside to duel for the lead, fought back on the turn, dropped back into the stretch and also weakened. WHATEVER WHENEVER dueled between horses on the backstretch and turn, fought back between foes in the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. WINESHINE chased between horses on the backstretch, dropped back off the rail into and on the turn and lacked a further response.
