Footnotes

YANKEE GONE SOUTH had speed three deep then set a pressured pace outside a rival, inched away in midstretch and held sway under urging. QUICK ENOUGH sent between horses early, chased outside a rival, angled in on the turn, came out into the stretch and again nearing midstretch nd just got the place. HE'S A DANCE STAR had good early speed between horses then prompted the pace inside to the stretch, could not quite match the winner in the final furlong and just lost second. MASTER CHEF chased between horses then outside a rival or off the rail, angled to the inside in the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. CAUGHT A FLYER stalked inside then a bit off the rail leaving the turn, swung out into the stretch and weakened. BUYER'S REMORSE between horses early, chased inside, steadied in tight along the rail into the turn, came out a bit into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. MAKER (ARG) broke in a bit, settled three deep then angled in a bit off the rail without early speed and did not rally. REAGAN REPUBLICAN was in a good position stalking the pace three deep or outside a rival, came out a bit into the stretch and weakened.
