FLEET CONTINENTAL stalked outside a rival then angled in on the backstretch, saved ground on the turn, bid inside in the stretch, gained the lead under urging in deep stretch and gamely prevailed. BULLYBULLYBULLY had speed outside a rival then inched away and angled in, battled inside on the turn,

inched away from that rival again in the stretch, battled alongside the winner in deep stretch and just held second. GET MY FIX chased between horses or outside rival, came three deep into the stretch and finished with interest three wide on the line. WILD AND TRUE stalked between horses on the backstretch and turn, split rivals at the wire and just missed third. RED SCARE sent along inside then stalked a bit off the rail, bid alongside the runner-up on the turn and into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. PREFERRED MANDATE chased inside, steadied in tight midway on the backstretch, saved ground on the turn, continued a long the rail in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. TRUENO between horses early, chased a bit off the rail then inside on the turn, came out into the stretch and lacked the necessary response. MAGICAL INSTINCT settled outside then three deep on the turn, came out five wide into the stretch and did not rally. BORN TO WALTZ angled in between foes early, dropped back off the rail into and on the turn and was not a threat. BATTLE SCHOOL chased outside then alongside a rival, went three deep on the turn and four wide into the stretch and weakened. JOHNNIE GOLD hesitated to be away behind the field, saved ground off the pace and was outrun.
