MAZEL TRICK, forced the pace along the inside in hand, was momentarily in a bit tight on the backstretch, took the lead into the second turn, shook off TIBADO approaching the stretch to get clear and drew off under a steady hand ride. RIVER KEEN (IRE) saved ground off the pace, moved up inside early on the second turn, came out leaving that turn and three deep into the stretch to be second best. TIBADO was sent to the early lead, set a pressured pace outside the winner, fought back when initially headed but weakened in the stretch. BUDROYALE stalked the leaders off the rail, dropped back on the second turn, came four wide into the stretch, then gave way and was not urged through the lane.
