TUCKED AWAY settled between horses then inside, moved up along the rail on the second turn, split rivals leaving that turn, came out three deep into the stretch, rallied under urging to gain the lead in deep stretch and held gamely. HOLLYWOOD STORY unhurried three deep on the first turn, settled outside a rival, went up four wide leaving the second turn and five wide into the stretch and closed willingly. VALENTINE DANCER stalked outside a rival then bid outside the pacesetter on the backstretch and second turn, took a short lead into the stretch, inched clear, weakened some late but held third. SANTA CANDIDA (ARG) broke through the gate before the start, settled inside, came out leaving the second turn and into the stretch and finished with interest, then did not return to be unsaddled and was vanned off. STAR PARADE (ARG) stalked the pace inside, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. MUIR BEACH chased outside a rival, came out four wide into the stretch, steadied in tight in upper stretch and could not summon the necessary late kick. GIRL WARRIOR broke through the gate before the start, chased a bit off the rail then inside on the second turn and weakened in the stretch. ALPHABET KISSES sped to the early lead and angled in, set a pressured pace along the inside and also weakened in the stretch. A claim of foul by the rider of MUIR BEACH against the winner for alleged interference in upper stretch was not allowed by the stewards, who ruled STAR PARADE was the cause of the trouble.
