CAPTURE THE CALL sped to the early lead, set all the pace inside or a bit off the rail, kicked clear on the second turn and proved best under urging. CANYON DRIVE stalked inside or just off the rail, continued along the fence on the second turn and into the stretch and edged a rival for the place. LADDIES POKER broke out a bit, pulled his way along to chase the pace outside then three deep on the backstretch and second turn and into the stretch and held third. MR. HOT STUFF allowed to settle outside a rival, found the rail on the second turn, continued inside in the stretch and was not a threat. BLAZING SPIRIT pulled his way along off the rail then stalked inside, was in a bit tight into the second turn, came out leaving that bend and three deep into the stretch and lacked a rally. INDY RIDE unhurried along the inside early, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. FIRE BREAK pulled early, stalked off the inside then between horses on the backstretch and turn and weakened in the stretch.
