MCKENZIES WAY had good early speed and angled in on the backstretch, dueled inside, kicked clear in the stretch and proved best under left handed urging. HOLLYWOOD HEIST sent between horses early, steadied in tight five eighths out, stalked inside, came a bit off the rail in the stretch and was second best while the rider dropped the whip at the wire. DOUGHBOY between foes early, angled in off the heels of the winner and stalked inside, came out on the turn and three deep into the stretch and held third. COMPETENT chased between horses on the backstretch and turn, came out into the stretch and was outfinished for the show. DESERT PARADISE was in a good position chasing the pace between horses then a bit off the rail, angled in on the turn, continued inside in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. REAL HEART moved up between horses then dueled outside the winner and weakened in the stretch. TWICE THE APPEAL allowed to settle outside then off the rail, came out four wide into the stretch and was not a threat. DIAMOND TOUCH stalked outside then four wide on the backstretch and turn, came five wide into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. GREAT RISING STAR broke slowly, settled off the rail, angled in some on the turn, came out into the stretch and failed to menace. TART N SMART stalked between horses then outside, came four wide into the stretch and weakened. CODE BUSTER balked at being reloaded into the gate, went up inside early, steadied in tight five eighths

out, came out in the stretch and failed to menace. SNETTISHAM a bit slow into stride, settled just off the rail, split horses into the stretch and was not a factor. A claim of foul by the rider of DOUGHBOY against the winner for alleged interference in the early going was not allowed by the stewards, who ruled the incident did not alter the original order of finish.
