MENSA HEAT bobbled at the start, recovered to chase the pace inside a rival down the backstretch and around the turn, came into the stretch three wide, was floated out slightly at the top of the lane, rallied to the lead at the furlong marker and drew clear late. CHOSEN MIRACLE was hustled on the inside to make the early lead, dueled inside WALL STREET WONDER down the backstretch and around the turn, relinquished command at the top of the lane, fought back on the inside through the final furlong and held the place. WALL STREET WONDER pulled his way along while pressing the pace on the outside down the backstretch and around the turn, shifted out at the top of the lane, gave up the lead at the furlong pole and was edged for the place in the late stages. LEGAL SEPARATION chased the pace off the rail down the backstretch and turn, angled to the rail in the final furlong but lacked a sufficient rally. KELLY LEAK chased the pace outside the winner down the backstretch, moved in tandem with that one four wide around the turn, came into the stretch four wide and weakened in the final furlong.
