JUST LIKE THAT (FR) chased a bit off the rail, came out four wide into the stretch and rallied under urging then steady handling late to be along in time. OREANDA dueled inside, regained the lead into the second turn, fought back into the stretch, drifted out under left handed urging in deep stretch and again at the wire to bump ROYAL SWEETPEA and could not hold off the winner. ROYAL SWEETPEA dueled outside OREANDA, fought back on the second turn and into the stretch, was forced out in deep stretch then bumped at the wire. NO MORE BLUES chased inside then a bit off the rail, came out into the stretch and finished well. SILVER HAWK LADY stalked the early pace off the rail, bid three deep on the backstretch, tracked the dueling leaders off the inside on the second turn and could not summon the necessary late response. THAT LOOK took an awkward step in the chute, settled outside a rival, dropped far back and gave way. IAMLLOUIE SISTER broke out and steadied, saved ground off the pace and was done early. Following a stewards' inquiry, OREANDA was disqualified and placed third for interference in deep stretch.
