LET'SPICKUPTHEPACE sped to the early lead, dueled inside, inched away a half mile out, kicked clear on the turn and proved best under a brisk hand ride

and a long hold late. MATCHING WHITES wide early, dropped back off the rail then angled in leaving the backstretch, swung four wide into the stretch and finished fast to gain the place. UNCLE JEEP had speed between foes then dueled outside the winner, stalked off the rail leaving the backstretch and between horses on the turn, came out some into the stretch and just held third. I WANNA GO FAST stalked outside then four wide into and on the turn and into the stretch and just missed the show. SCORPIO DOG chased between horses then a bit off the rail to the stretch and lacked the needed rally. YVETT'S HOPE chased outside then alongside a rival into and on the turn and could not summon the necessary response. LITTLE LIZARD pulled his way along between horses then stalked three deep, was three wide between foes on the turn and into the stretch and weakened. SPORTY GUY allowed to settle off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and did not rally. HEAD OF THE GAME chased between horses then a bit off the inside, angled to the fence on the turn, came out in midstretch and was not a threat. MY MAN SUMO stalked inside, came a bit off the rail leaving the turn and into the stretch, drifted back in and weakened. TACHOMETER broke a bit slowly, came out and went between horses to stalk the pace, continued inside on the turn and also weakened. RECKLESS CAPOTE wide between foes early, angled in on the backstretch and saved ground but was outrun.
