ACCLAMATION sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, shook off a rival into the second turn to inch away again, drifted off the inside some in the stretch but won clear under a steady hand ride. ADAM SUANCES stalked the pace inside, came out into the stretch, angled back to the inside in the drive and was second best. SUIT YOURSELF pulled his way along to stalk the pace three deep, continued three wide into the stretch and bested the others. WARREN'S TONY R. between horses early, chased a bit off the rail then inside, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. BLACKBRIAR broke a bit slowly, settled inside then came off the rail into the backstretch, went outside a rival on the second turn and three deep into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. ONE CHIN AGAIN pulled a bit three deep early, chased outside a rival then just off the inside and weakened in the stretch. CLARENCE PEAK chased inside the tugged his way along just off the rail on the backstretch, went outside a rival into and on the second turn, dropped back leaving that turn and lacked a further response. ONE VOTE also pulled early, stalked off the rail then outside a rival, bid alongside the winner on the backstretch, dropped back between foes on the second turn and weakened.
