VESPUCCI sped to the early lead, angled in and set the pace inside, came a bit off the rail in the stretch and held on gamely under urging. SPURRIER close up stalking the winner inside, came out leaving the second turn and into the stretch and finished willingly. CIGAR MAN between horses early, stalked off the rail then between rivals on the backstretch and into the second turn, angled to the inside leaving that turn and into the stretch and bested the others. YANKEE STATION was in a good position stalking the pace three deep to the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. QUINDICI MAN settled a bit off the rail, went up between horses on the backstretch and second turn, came three deep into the stretch and could not summon the necessary response. MR. BIG broke in and a bit slowly, settled outside, went up four wide on the backstretch and second turn and into the stretch and did not rally. EL TROFEO (ARG) pulled his way along inside and was in a bit tight into the first turn, chased along the rail, was in a bit tight again midway on the backstretch, continued inside and lacked a response in the drive. SELF MADE MAN stalked outside a rival then between horses on the backstretch and second turn, dropped back between foes leaving that turn and weakened.
