LANG FIELD sped to the early lead, angled in and set the pace inside, opened up on the second turn and into the stretch and held gamely under some urging. SEMINOLE NATIVE settled inside, came out a bit into the stretch, split rivals in deep stretch and surged outside the winner late. WILD AND READY angled in and settled outside a rival, angled in on the second turn, remained inside in the stretch and edged a rival for third. STAND TALL chased inside then a bit off the rail, split horses in midstretch and was edged for the show. DEADSHOT KEEN (IRE) three deep into the first turn, angled in and stalked a bit off the rail then inside, came out in the stretch, was between foes in midstretch and lacked the needed late kick. APPTOBURN close up stalking the winner off the rail, drifted four wide into the stretch and weakened. ROBSCARVIC (IRE) chased outside or off the rail, came out four wide into the stretch

and could not offer the necessary response. CAPT. SPARROW settled just off the inside then chased along the rail on the backstretch, continued toward the inside on the second turn and was not a threat. SHIMBY (CHI) pulled between horses early, chased outside a rival then a bit off the rail, dropped back on the second turn and weakened. MINISTER BLAIR was in a good position stalking the pace outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch and also weakened. Finish confirmed by Equibase.
