Footnotes

SMOKEY LONESOME saved ground chasing the pace, came out on the second turn and three deep into the stretch, bid three wide past midstretch, gained the lead in deep stretch and gamely prevailed under urging. SURREY STAR (IRE) settled inside stalking the pace, moved up into the stretch, was blocked off heels in midstretch, came out and split horses late for the place. BUENOS DIAS (IRE) a bit crowded at the start, was unhurried outside then alongside a rival, went three deep into and out of the second turn and finished well three wide on the line. QUAIL HILL broke out a bit, sped to the early lead and angled in, set the pace inside, fought back along the rail in the stretch and was outfinished late. ROYAL F J stalked outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch, bid alongside the pacesetter to gain a short lead in the stretch, fought back between horses in deep stretch and also was outfinished. MEGASTAR chased outside a rival, split horses leaving the backstretch, continued a bit off the rail on the second turn, angled to the inside for the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. ATTICUS JACK four wide leaving the chute, stalked off the rail to the stretch and weakened. MR. CANDY BAR saved ground off the pace, came off the rail in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. MICHAEL THE MAN wide in the chute, angled in and chased outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch and weakened. TIPPETY TAP TAP settled off the pace inside, came a bit off the rail on the second turn and did not rally.
