### Footnotes

**BROOKLYN ROSE** chased between horses or outside, advanced three deep on the turn and outside a rival into the stretch, bid between foes in midstretch, gained the lead a sixteenth out and proved best under urging. **QUEEN MERCURY** bumped at the start, was sent between horses to duel for the lead, battled inside on the turn, fought back in the stretch, could not match the winner late but held second. **BILA SHAKA** hopped slightly and bobbed in an awkward start, stalked outside, bid three deep between foes into the stretch, was four wide in midstretch and bested the others. **BRAZILIAN CHARM** dueled three deep then outside a rival on the turn, battled between horses in midstretch and weakened. **WARREN'S PERFORMER** stalked outside then went four wide on the turn and into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. **SEARFAVORITSESECRET** stalked the pace inside, steadied in tight off heels early on the turn and again nearing the quarter pole, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. **LANA'S LOVELY** had speed between horses, dueled a bit off the rail then dropped back inside on the turn and weakened. **BELLA MARINO** broke out, bumped a rival and steadied, then was in tight in the early going, chased a bit off the rail, split horses on the turn, came out into the stretch and lacked a further response.
