**Footnotes**

WISHING GATE angled in and pulled her way along to chase outside a rival, steadied five eighths out, came out three wide into the stretch and rallied under left handed urging to get up late. JERRY'SHONEYCAROL pulled between horses early then stalked inside, bid along the rail in the stretch, gained the lead a sixteenth out but could not hold off the winner. DANCE TEAM had speed between horses then dueled inside, inched clear in the stretch, battled outside the runner-up a sixteenth out and held third. SHRILANKA a bit slow to begin, angled in and settled just off the rail, angled to the inside in upper stretch and just missed the show. PURPLE PROSE also broke a bit slowly, angled in and saved ground chasing the pace, came out in upper stretch, drifted out in midstretch and lacked the needed rally. RENEE'S QUEEN balked at loading, pulled her way between horses then dueled outside a rival to the stretch and weakened. LADY ONE EIGHTY three deep into the first turn, stalked outside a rival then three wide leaving the backstretch and into the second turn, dropped back on that turn, angled in off heels nearing midstretch and weakened. EXPLOSIVE ARGUMENT saved ground chasing the pace, continued between horses on the second turn, dropped back in the stretch, steadied off heels in midstretch and also weakened. ECONOMY OF MOTION four wide early, stalked outside a rival then three deep on the second turn, came out into the stretch and had little left for the drive.
