Footnotes

BRILLIANT MELODY prompted the pace outside a rival then stalked off the rail on the turn, re-bid into the stretch, gained the advantage in upper stretch, inched away under left handed urging past midstretch and proved best. ATTA GIRL ALMA saved ground stalking the pace, came out leaving the turn and into the stretch and gained the place late. PROMISCOUSSUANCES had good early speed and dueled inside, inched away on the turn, fought back in upper and midstretch, could not match the winner in the final sixteenth and just lost second. NAVA NATALY was in a good position stalking the pace outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch, drifted in and lacked the needed late kick. LUXURIANCE chased outside a rival on the backstretch and turn, angled three wide into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. PUFF PASTRY broke slowly, settled a bit off the rail, came out leaving the turn, swung four wide into the stretch and did not rally. HORSESANDDIVORCES a bit slow to begin, went up inside to stalk the pace, continued along the rail on the turn and into the stretch and weakened.
