Footnotes

BARDY saved ground chasing the pace, came out some in the stretch and rallied between horses under urging in the late stages to get up on the wire. CHOCOLATIER pulled along the inside and steadied off heels into the first turn, came out three deep leaving that turn, moved up between horses on the

backstretch and three wide on the second turn, took the lead outside the pacesetter into the stretch, inched away in the drive and was caught on the line. TIZ FUTURITY allowed to settle off the rail, continued three wide on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and rallied outside in the drive to be three across the track on the wire. AFFIRMED ARCH had speed four wide then three deep into the first turn, inched away and angled in, opened up on the backstretch, set the pace inside, fought back into the stretch and weakened some in the final furlong. POINT HAPPY saved ground chasing the pace, moved up inside leaving the backstretch then was in tight off heels into the second turn, continued along the rail into the stretch, came out a bit in deep stretch and was outfinished. RISESEASTSETSWEST stalked off the rail then outside a rival, continued between foes on the second turn, was a bit crowded when the winner went by a sixteenth out and lacked the needed late kick. ANCIENT STONE chased between horses or outside a rival, split foes on the second turn, came three deep into the stretch and did not rally. TRIPLE JEOPARDY settled between foes then three deep, continued a bit off the rail leaving the backstretch and on the second turn, went around a rival into the stretch and was not a threat. DUTCH COURAGE angled in on the first turn and stalked inside, came out into the stretch and weakened. NEIL HEALY chased between horses then outside a rival, dropped back off the rail on the second turn and had little left for the stretch. PERFECT JERSEY chased four and five wide to the second turn, angled in three deep then came out five wide into the stretch, gave way and was eased in the drive. MR. FITZRAMATHORN sent along six wide early and four wide into the first turn, drifted out while being pulled up leaving that turn but was walked off.
