SYNNIN AND GRINNIN had good early speed and dueled a bit off the rail then inside, inched away on the turn and drew off in the stretch under a brisk hand ride. ANOTHER ALEYNA chased four wide then outside a rival on the turn, came three deep into the stretch and edged foes for second between horses on the wire. ASHTON GIRL (IRE) broke slowly, pulled her way along off the rail then outside, came out in the stretch and just got the show three deep on the line. AUNT PINK chased between horses then inside on the turn, came out into the stretch, split rivals in midstretch and just missed a minor award, then did not return to be unsaddled and was vanned off. CANTINA'S ROSE settled outside a rival, came out some in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. MASTERFUL MISS saved ground off the pace, came out some in the stretch and did not rally. MAMA KNOWS BEST stalked early then bid outside the winner to press the pace, tracked that one off the rail on the turn, drifted in some in the stretch and weakened. NOOK AND GRANNY had good early speed then stalked the pace inside to the stretch and also weakened.
